June 4th, 2025

The Mission City Council met in regular session at 6:03pm on June 4th, 2025, at the Mission City Office. The members present were Mayor Petersen, Lavery, Vargas, Iron Heart, Guerue, and Sedlmajer. Others present were Daniel Brave, Cole Dubray (Maintenance Supervisor), Trevor Willcuts (Chief of Police).

Motion by Guerue, seconded by Sedlmajer to approve the agenda with the following addition: Surveillance cameras.

Motion by Sedlmajer, seconded by Iron Heart to approve May 27th, 2025, minutes.

Chief of Police, Trevor Willcuts, provided the council with a verbal and written report on all police activity from May 1st, 2025, through May 31st, 2025. The statistics show 182 total traffic stops, 167 warnings given, 56 public intoxications, 9 DUI/Drug stops, 47 vandalisms/break-ins (Combined) and other contacts like accidents and shots fired calls, totaling the number of contacts to 384.

The maintenance supervisor, Cole Dubray, provided the council with a verbal and written report on all the maintenance up-keep from 4-17-25 through 6-4-25. The report includes the initials and description of what each worker got done each day. Daily maintenance work includes emptying trash, mowing throughout town and ball fields, weed trimming, checking the lift station and lagoons ect.

They also accept phone calls for assistance which include turning water on and off at specified locations, patching roads on specified streets, locating shut-off valves, ect.

Motion by Sedlmajer, seconded by Lavery to add surveillance cameras in the City Office.

After motion there was also discussion on how we can add surveillance cameras to the park and ball field.

Motion by Sedlmajer, seconded by Iron Heart to adjourn meeting at 7:11pm.
