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Report

Fire Department Report: Joseph Moore, Fire Chief

Moore discussed plans to complete welding modifications on the tinder fire truck by Friday, with the A/C still needing repair. The group reviewed fire incident reporting requirements, deciding to implement quarterly pie charts showing fire types and numbers, and discussed transitioning to a new reporting system called National Emergency Response Incident System.

Moore reported on recent fire calls since February, including mutual aid responses to Kilgore and a structure fire near Oak Creek, as well as issues with Engine 5 experiencing mechanical problems. The council discussed a Wildland Fire Academy cancellation and associated reimbursements, along with grant applications including a VFA grant for chainsaws and equipment worth approximately \$7,000, and a Homeland Security grant for radios and a repeater system.
